Startup assistance group expands into Alabama

An entrepreneur assistance organization is expanding into Alabama and seeking entries for its third-quarter 2009 roundtable discussion.

The **Start-Up Council** is a group of industry experts that support emerging companies. It started in 2006 and now has representatives from Georgia, South Carolina, Tennessee and North Carolina.

The third-quarter roundtable will be held Sept. 22 in Marietta, Ga. Entries to participate in the roundtable discussion will be accepted until Sept. 10.

The council provides free counsel to entrepreneurs launching new businesses by providing guidance on public relations, funding, legal, business development, outsourced manufacturing, marketing and branding, according to a news release.
